Chris Pigors, **Fayette County Sheriff candidate**, is a devoted husband for over 21 years and a dedicated father. He is running for Sheriff because he believes safe communities are built on mutual respect and strong relationships between law enforcement officials and the people they serve.

Chris graduated summa cum laude with a BA degree in Criminal Justice from Saint Leo University. He was one of the first law enforcement officers, in the State of Georgia, to be Crises Intervention Certified (CIT). He has held the positions of corrections officer, field trainer, investigator, master patrol officer, sergeant, shift commander, captain and assistant division commander.
